1. Are there things that you have previously heard taught about divorce that were confusing?
2. Jesus said that Moses “allowed” divorce as a concession because of their hard hearts. What does this teach us about divorce and its relationship to our human inclination to sin?
3. Jesus’ view of marriage comes from Genesis 2:24 (read it). Jesus adds to this “what God has joined together, let no man separate.” What does this teach us about the sacredness of marriage? The permanence of marriage?
4. How does a covenant marriage reflect the Trinity? Jesus and the Church?
5. Rev Kev said that the Bible seems to allow divorce for sexual unfaithfulness, desertion, and/or abuse (although it should be noted that there are many Bible teachers with differing views). However, divorce should always be the last resort. Do you agree with these perspectives? Why or why not?
6. For those who are single: How do you view your ‘singleness’ in light of Jesus’ words about marriage & divorce?
7. For those who are married: Have you had to ‘fight for you marriage’?
8. For those divorced: Have you been able to receive God’s grace and healing? If not, is there something that is keeping you from experiencing these things? How can we support and love you to that end?
